12 PERIOD ENDING JUNE 30, 2007; AND FOR OTHER  
13 PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF RURAL  
17 SERVICES APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2005-2007  
18 BIENNIUM.  
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22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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24 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the  
25 Department of Rural Services for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following  
26 maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the  
27 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code  
28 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.  
29 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual  
30 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of  
31 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying  
32 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the  
33 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),  
34 or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Department of Rural Services for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: two (2) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Rural Services, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the Department of Rural Services - State Operations for the biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

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3 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATIONS - CONFERENCE EXPENSES. There is hereby
4 appropriated, to the Department of Rural Services, to be payable from cash
5 funds as defined by Arkansas Code 19-4-801 of the Department of Rural
6 Services, for conference expenses of the Department of Rural Services for the
7 biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

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14 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
15 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COUNTY
16 FAIR GRANTS. The Department of Rural Services shall develop the necessary
17 rules and regulations for the disbursement of matching fund grants to county
18 fairs for the construction of new or replacement buildings. The grants shall
19 be matched on a 50/50 basis. The match may be cash or in-kind. No county
20 fair shall receive more than \$30,000 for the biennium.

21 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
22 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

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24 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
25 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. GRANT
26 AWARD CRITERIA. The Department of Rural Services shall promulgate regulations
27 establishing the criteria to be utilized in determining to whom grants will
28 be made under this Act. Subject to the approval of the Governor, and after
29 prior review by the Arkansas Legislative Council or the Joint Budget
30 Committee, the Department of Rural Services shall distribute the grants. The
31 provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 2005
32 through June 30, 2005 2007.

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34 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
35 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
36 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the

1 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
2 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
3 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
4 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
6 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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8 SECTION 8. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
9 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
10 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
11 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
12 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
13 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
14 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
15 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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17 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the  
19 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the  
20 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of  
21 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in  
22 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective  
23 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the  
24 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.  
25 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being  
26 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
27 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
