SENATE BILL 136

For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND
10 SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO PROVIDE REASONABLE
11 ACCOMMODATIONS FOR STUDENTS WITH IRLLEN SYNDROME
12 WHEN ADMINISTERING STATE REQUIRED TESTS; AND FOR
13 OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DEPARTMENT OF
17 EDUCATION AND SCHOOL DISTRICTS TO
18 PROVIDE REASONABLE ACCOMMODATIONS FOR
19 STUDENTS WITH IRLLEN SYNDROME WHEN
20 ADMINISTERING STATE REQUIRED TESTS.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

25 SECTION 1. Any student that has been identified as having Irlen
26 Syndrome, otherwise known as Scotopic Sensitivity Syndrome, shall be allowed
27 to use color overlays to alter the contrast between the words and the page
28 and other reasonable accommodations necessary when taking any state mandated
29 assessment.
