30 SECTION 3. EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEYS. None of the funds appropriated in 31 this Act for Maintenance and General Operation shall be expended in payment 32 for services of attorneys, unless the agency shall first make a request in 33 writing to the Attorney General of the State of Arkansas to provide the 34 required legal services. The Attorney General's Office shall provide the 35 requested legal services, or, if the Attorney General's Office shall 36 determine that sufficient personnel are not available to provide the

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requested legal services, the Attorney General shall certify the same to the
agency and may authorize the agency to employ legal counsel and to expend
monies appropriated for Maintenance and General Operations therefor, if:

4 (1) The Attorney General determines, and certifies in writing, that such 5 agency needs the advice or assistance of legal counsel, and

6 (2) The Attorney General consents in writing to the employment of the7 legal counsel to be retained by the agency.

8 Such certification shall be required with respect to each instance of the 9 employment of special legal counsel, or shall be required annually with 10 respect to legal counsel employed on a retainer basis. A copy of such 11 certification shall be entered in the official minutes of the agency, and 12 shall be retained in the fiscal records of the agency for audit purposes. 13

14 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 15 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 16 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 17 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 18 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 19 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 20 21 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 22 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

24 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 25 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 26 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 27 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 28 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 29 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 30 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 31

33 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General

34 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the

35 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
