19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 4-28-412 is amended to read as follows:  
22 4-28-412. Prohibited acts.

23 It shall be a violation of this section for:

24 (1) Any person to make any misrepresentation, either express or  
25 implied, during the course of soliciting funds for a charitable organization;

26 (2) Any charitable organization to engage in any financial  
27 transaction which knowingly jeopardizes or interferes with the ability of the  
28 charitable organization to accomplish its charitable purpose;

29 (3) Any person to knowingly use or exploit the fact of  
30 registration so as to lead the public to believe that such registration  
31 constitutes an endorsement or approval by the state;

32 (4) Any person to knowingly misrepresent that any other person  
33 sponsors or endorses a solicitation;

34 (5) Any person to knowingly either use the name of a charitable  
35 organization or display any emblem, device, or printed matter belonging to or  
36 associated with a charitable organization without the express written



1 permission of the charitable organization;

2 (6) Any charitable organization to knowingly use a name which is  
3 the same as or confusingly similar to the name of another charitable  
4 organization unless the latter organization shall consent in writing to its  
5 use;

6 (7) Any charitable organization to represent itself as being  
7 associated with another charitable organization without the express written  
8 acknowledgment and endorsement of the other charitable organization;

9 (8) Any person to knowingly make any false or misleading  
10 statements on any document required to be filed with the Attorney General;

11 (9) Any person to fail to substantially comply with the  
12 requirements of this subchapter;

13 (10) Any charitable organization to use the services of an  
14 unregistered paid solicitor who is required to register pursuant to this  
15 subchapter; ~~and~~

16 (11) Any paid solicitor to solicit contributions from citizens  
17 or entities located in this state on behalf of an unregistered charitable  
18 organization; and

19 (12) Any charitable organization to use an address, including a  
20 return address, in this state, in any solicitation unless:

21 (A) The charitable organization maintains and staffs an  
22 office at that address;

23 (B) The solicitation discloses in writing immediately  
24 proximate to the listing of the address located in this state:

25 (i) The address of the charitable organization's  
26 actual headquarters; and

27 (ii) That the address in this state is a mail drop  
28 box or a mail handling facility; or

29 (C) If the solicitation is over the phone, the solicitor  
30 discloses the address of the organization's actual headquarters in addition  
31 to any address maintained in this state.
