(b) The environmental officer may complete the training course for law enforcement officers at the Law Enforcement Training Academy. After satisfactory completion of said course the environmental officer shall be a law enforcement officer. (c) After completing the training course at the Law Enforcement Training Academy, the environmental officer may: (1) carry Carry firearms; (2) execute Execute and serve any warrant or other processes issued under the authority of the county or regional solid waste district pertaining to violations of county or regional solid waste district ordinances concerning environmental protection,; and (3) make Make arrests and issue citations for violations of county or regional solid waste district ordinances concerning environmental protection.
