After satisfactory completion of said course the environmental officer shall be a law enforcement officer. (c) After completing the training course at the Law Enforcement Training Academy, the environmental officer may: (1) carry Carry firearms; (2) execute Execute and serve any warrant or other processes issued under the authority of the county or regional solid waste district pertaining to violations of county or regional solid waste district ordinances or regulations concerning environmental protection; and (3) make Make arrests and issue citations for violations of county or regional solid waste district ordinances or regulations concerning environmental protection. /s/ Madison
