16 WITH THE SAME AUTHORITY AS COUNTY

21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 8-6-704(b), regarding the powers and duties
24 of regional solid waste management boards, is amended to read as follows:

25 (b)(1) The regional solid waste management boards may:

26 ~~(1)(A)~~ Apply for such permits, licenses, certificates, or
27 approvals as may be necessary to construct, maintain, and operate any portion
28 of a solid waste management system and to obtain, hold, and use licenses,
29 permits, certificates, or approvals in the same manner as any other person or
30 operating unit of any other person;

31 ~~(2)(B)~~ Employ such engineers, architects, attorneys, real
32 estate counselors, appraisers, financial advisors, and other consultants and
33 employees as may be required in the judgment of the district and fix and pay
34 their compensation from funds available to the district therefor; ~~and~~

35 ~~(3)(C)~~ Purchase all kinds of insurance, including, but not
36 limited to, insurance against tort liability, business interruption, and



1 risks of damage to property; and

2 (D) Employ an environmental officer who may:

3 (i) Inspect all landfills;

4 (ii) Inspect other solid waste facilities;

5 (iii) Inspect waste haulers and other vehicles;

6 (iv) Insure compliance with all district

7 regulations;

8 (v) Collect evidence of noncompliance and present
9 the evidence to the prosecuting attorney; or

10 (vi) Issue citations for the violation of any
11 regulation throughout the district.

12 (2)(A) If a regional solid waste management board employs an
13 environmental officer under this subsection (b), then the environmental
14 officer may complete the training course for law enforcement officers at the
15 Arkansas Law Enforcement Training Academy.

16 (B) After satisfactory completion of the training course,
17 the environmental officer shall be a law enforcement officer.

18 (C) After satisfactory completion of the training course,
19 the environmental officer may:

20 (i) Carry firearms;

21 (ii) Execute and serve a warrant or other processes
22 issued under the authority of the district and related to violations of
23 district regulations; and

24 (iii) Make arrests and issue citations for
25 violations of district regulations regarding environmental protection.
