## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN AUTOMATIC SURVIVOR BENEFIT FOR MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM THAT ARE MARRIED AND DO NOT ELECT ANOTHER FORM OF BENEFIT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO PROVIDE AN AUTOMATIC SURVIVOR BENEFIT FOR MEMBERS OF THE ARKANSAS

LOCAL POLICE AND FIRE RETIREMENT SYSTEM
THAT ARE MARRIED AND DO NOT ELECT
ANOTHER FORM OF BENEFIT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 24-10-603(c), pertaining to annuity options, is amended as follows:
(c)(1) If a member does not elect an option, his or her annuity shall be paid to him or her as an Option A60 annuity provided for under subdivision (a) (l) of this section.
(2) Beginning July 1, 2005, a member who is married at the date of retirement and does not elect an option, his or her annuity shall be paid to him or her as an Option B75 annuity provided for under subdivision (a) (4) of this section.

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that for the effective
administration of this act and to avoid undue harm to the members and benefit recipients of the Arkansas Local Police and Fire Retirement System that this act should become effective on July 1, 2005. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act being necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on July l, 2005.
