SENATE BILL 195

For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ARKANSAS STATE MEDICAL
10 BOARD TO ISSUE EDUCATIONAL LICENSES TO PRACTICE
11 MEDICINE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

14 AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE ARKANSAS STATE
15 MEDICAL BOARD TO ISSUE EDUCATIONAL
16 MEDICAL LICENSES.

19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 17, Chapter 95, Subchapter 4 is amended
22 to add an additional section to read as follows:

23 17-95-412. Educational Licenses.

24 (a) The Arkansas State Medical Board may issue an educational license
25 to practice medicine to any physician who meets:

26 (1) The qualifications and requirements set forth in the board's
27 rules; and

28 (2) The conditions and requirements set forth in subsection (b)
29 of this section.

30 (b)(1) The physician shall:

31 (A) Submit an application to the board; and

32 (B) Provide such information as the board may by rule
33 require.

34 (2) The physician shall pay a licensure fee that the board may
35 set by rule to cover the costs of administering the program.

36 (3) The physician shall be serving as a faculty member at an



1 academic medical program established by and under the control of the
2 University of Arkansas for Medical Sciences.

3 (4) The educational license to practice medicine in the State of
4 Arkansas shall authorize the practice of medicine only within the clinical
5 and educational programs established and administered by the University of
6 Arkansas for Medical Sciences.

7 (c)(1) The board shall issue each educational license for a period of
8 one (1) year.

9 (2) At the end of the one (1) year, the license shall lapse and
10 the physician shall make an additional application to the board if the
11 physician desires to continue the practice of medicine.

12 (d) A physician who obtains an educational license to practice
13 medicine in the State of Arkansas shall comply with the Arkansas Medical
14 Practices Act §§ 17-95-201 - 17-95-207, 17-95-301 - 17-95-305, and 17-95-401
15 - 17-95-411, and all rules of the board.
