NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. LEGAL 9 10 RESEARCH SPECIALIST NEW HIRE REQUIREMENT. Any new hire for the Class Code 11 9109, Legal Research Specialist, Grade 25 positions as established in Section 12 8 9 herein must first have prior approval of the Personnel Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee. 13 14 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 15 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 16 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 17 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 18 19 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly 20 has determined that the Administrative Office of the Courts may operate more 21 efficiently if some flexibility is provided to the Administrative Office of 22 the Courts authorizing broad powers under this Section. Therefore, it is both 23 necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight by 24 requiring prior approval of the Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee 25 as provided by this section. The requirement of approval by the Legislative 26 Council or Joint Budget Committee is not a severable part of this section. 27 If the requirement of approval by the Legislative Council or Joint Budget 28 Committee is ruled unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, 29 this entire section is void. 30 31 SECTION 31. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 32 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 33 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 34 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 35 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 36

19	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
20	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
21	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
22	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
23	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
24	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
