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25	SECTION 1. Arkans	as Code § 19-4-702(d), pertain	ning to time limits for

27	(d) <u>(l)(A)</u> In the	event a biweekly pay period fo	or personal services, as
28	defined in §§ 19-4-521 a	and 19-4-1607, commences in the	e closing period of one
29	(1) fiscal period and $\underline{\text{either}}$ ends in the following fiscal year $\underline{\text{or is paid in}}$		
30	the following fiscal year, then the payment of the obligation may be made in		
31	whole from the appropriation for either fiscal period, as determined by the		
32	Chief Fiscal Officer of the State.

36	(2)(A) For	purposes of wages and compensa	tion, the Chief Fiscal

1	Officer of the State may determine the starting date of authorized job		
2	classifications and positions to coincide with the payment of the obligation		
3	under subdivision (d)(l) of this section.		
4	(B) However, the determination under subdivision $(d)(2)(A)$		
5	of this section shall not cause any state fiscal year to be charged with		
6	fewer than twenty-six (26) or more than twenty-seven (27) biweekly pay		
7	periods.		
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9	SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
10	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that in order to more effectively		
11	manage and administer state budgetary matters, the Chief Fiscal Officer of		
12	the State needs the flexibility to determine the fiscal year funds from which		
13	the payment is made for a pay period that begins in one (1) fiscal year and		
14	ends in the subsequent fiscal year; that positions that start during a pay		
15	period that covers two (2) fiscal years create budgetary and accounting		
16	issues; that the Chief Fiscal Officer needs the flexibility to determine the		
17	start date for these positions; and that this act is immediately necessary in		
18	order to provide for appropriate budgetary and accounting measures before the		
19	end of the current fiscal year. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist		
20	and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public		
21	peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:		
22	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
23	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
24	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
25	bill; or		
26	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
27	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.		
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
