9	(a) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration may:		
10	(1) Accept any gifts, grants, bequests, devises, and donations		
11	made to the State of Arkansas for the purpose of funding the Military Family		
12	Relief Check-off Program; and		
13	(2) Deposit any gifts, grants, bequests, devises, and donations		
14	received under this subchapter into the Military Family Relief Trust Fund.		
15	(b) The Department of Finance and Administration shall quarterly		
16	certify to the Treasurer of State the amount contributed to the Military		
17	Family Relief Trust Fund through the state income tax checkoff created under		
18	this subchapter, and the Treasurer of State shall deduct from the Individual		
19	Income Tax Withholding Fund the amount certified.		
20	(c) The Director of the Department of Finance and Administration shall		
21	promulgate rules and all income tax forms, returns, and schedules necessary		
22	to carry out the revenue-producing provisions of this subchapter.		
23	(d) The gifts, grants, bequests, devises, and donations made under		
24	this subchapter shall be used together with any other funds appropriated for		
25	funding the Military Family Relief Trust Fund.		
26	(e) The Adjutant General of the State of Arkansas shall promulgate all		
27	rules necessary for implementing the grant program for the Military Family		
28	Relief Trust Fund.

30	26-35-1304. Implementation.		
31	(a) The Adjutant General of the State of Arkansas or his or her		
32	designee shall use funds from the Military Family Relief Trust Fund to		
33	establish a grant program to assist the families of members of the Arkansas		
34	National Guard and Reserves.		
35	(b)(1) The grant program created under this subchapter shall assist		
36	the families of members of the Arkansas National Guard and Reserves who serve		

1	on active duty for a minimum of thirty (30) days as a result of September 11,		
2	<u>2001.</u>		
3	(2) The eligibility criteria for receiving grants under the		
4	grant program shall include, but not be limited to, the following:		
5	(A) The need of the family;		
6	(B) The pay grade of the member of the Arkansas National		
7	Guard and Reserves;		
8	(C) The difference between the member's military salary		
9	and civilian salary; or		
10	(D) Any other factors that establish the family's		
11	financial hardship.

13	26-35-1306. Effective dates.		
14	(a) The Military Family Relief Check-off Program checkoff on state		
15	income tax returns shall be effective for tax years beginning on or after		
16	January 1, 2005.		
17	(b) The provisions of this subchapter allowing the Director of the		
18	Department of Finance and Administration to accept gifts, grants, bequests,		
19	devises, and donations shall be effective on August 1, 2005.		
20			
21	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code Title 19, Chapter 5, Subchapter 11 is amended		
22	to add an additional section to read as follows:		
23	19-5-1127. Military Family Relief Trust Fund.		
24	(a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the		
25	Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a trust fund to		
26	be known as the "Military Family Relief Trust Fund".		
27	(b)(1) All moneys collected under §§ 26-35-1302 and 26-35-1303 shall		
28	be deposited into the State Treasury to the credit of the fund.		
29	(2) The fund shall also consist of any other revenues as may be		
30	authorized by law.		
31	(c) The fund shall be used exclusively by the Adjutant General or his		
32	or her designee to assist the families of members of the Arkansas National		
33	Guard and Reserves who serve on active duty for a minimum of thirty (30) days		
34	as a result of September 11, 2001.		
35	(d) The Treasurer of State shall credit to the fund the amount		
36	certified each quarter in accordance with § 26-35-1303		

1	(e)(1) The moneys credited to the fund shall be held as trust funds in
2	interest-bearing accounts only.
3	(2) All interest earned shall be credited to the fund and shall
4	be used only for the purposes of the fund.
5	(f) All moneys deposited into the fund, all interest earned on
6	deposits, and the fund balance in the fund may be disbursed as appropriated
7	in each fiscal year of the biennium for the Military Family Relief Check-off
8	Program.
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
