25	(a) There is created on the books of the Treasurer of State, the
26	Auditor of State, and the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State a trust fund to
27	be known as the "Military Family Relief Trust Fund".
28	(b)(1) All moneys collected under §§ 26-35-1302 and 26-35-1303 shall
29	be deposited into the State Treasury to the credit of the fund.
30	(2) The fund shall also consist of any other revenues as may be
31	authorized by law.
32	(c) The fund shall be used exclusively by the Adjutant General or his
33	or her designee to assist the families of members of the Arkansas National
34	Guard and Reserves who serve on active duty for a minimum of thirty (30) days
35	as a result of September 11, 2001.
36	(d) The Treasurer of State shall credit to the fund the amount

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1	certified each quarter in accordance with § 26-35-1303.
2	(e)(1) The moneys credited to the fund shall be held as trust funds in
3	interest-bearing accounts only.
4	(2) All interest earned shall be credited to the fund and shall
5	be used only for the purposes of the fund.
6	(f) All moneys deposited into the fund, all interest earned on
7	deposits, and the fund balance in the fund may be disbursed as appropriated
8	in each fiscal year of the biennium for the Military Family Relief Check-off
