15	(5)(A) The State Board of Election Commissioners shall have the		
16	primary responsibility for conducting presidential preferential primary

18	(B) Within each county, the presidential preferential

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T	SECTION 2. Arkansas code § 7-6-204 is amended to read as follows:
2	7-8-204. Rules for selection of delegates and alternates.
3	Each political party holding a presidential preferential primary
4	election in the state shall adopt appropriate rules for the selection of
5	delegates and alternate delegates to the quadrennial national nominating
6	convention of the party and to otherwise carry out the intent and purposes of
7	this subchapter.
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9	SECTION 3. Arkansas Code § 7-8-302(5)(A), concerning political party
10	candidates for president and vice president, is amended to read as follows:
11	(5)(A) In order to have the name of a political party's candidates for
12	President and Vice President printed on the ballot, a political party shall
13	nominate by hold a presidential preferential primary election. A new
14	political party formed pursuant to the petition process may nominate by
15	convention if the presidential election is the first general election after
16	certification as a party by the Secretary of State.
