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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES. There is hereby established for the State
24 Crime Laboratory for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of
25 regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the provisions of the
26 Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et
27 seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto. Provided, however,
28 that any position to which a specific maximum annual salary is set out herein
29 in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of said Uniform
30 Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying positions
31 authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the Regular
32 Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101), or its
33 successor.

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27 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. HOPE DRUG
 29 LABORATORY OPERATIONS - MISCELLANEOUS AGENCIES FUND ACCOUNT ~~STATE CENTRAL~~
 30 ~~SERVICES FUND~~ CARRY FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of funds remaining on
 31 June 30th of any fiscal year resulting from monies transferred to the
 32 Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account ~~State Central Services Fund~~ for the
 33 personal services and operating expenses of the Hope Drug Laboratory shall be
 34 carried forward and made available solely for the same purpose after having
 35 prior approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.
 36 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of

1 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
2 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
3 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
4 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
5 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly
6 has determined that the State Crime Laboratory may operate more efficiently
7 if some flexibility is provided to the State Crime Laboratory authorizing

19 TRANSFER. Effective July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State
20 shall transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer the sum of five
21 hundred forty thousand six hundred sixty four dollars (\$540,664) ~~one hundred~~
22 ~~three thousand nine hundred sixty four dollars (\$103,964)~~ from the Special
23 State Assets Forfeiture Fund to the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account ~~State~~
24 ~~Central Services Fund~~ as a direct revenue to provide funds solely for the
25 appropriations authorized herein for the regular salaries, personal services
26 matching and maintenance and general operation of the Hope Drug Lab for the
27 biennial period ending June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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29 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
31 BALANCES - DNA DETECTION FUND. (A) For all appropriations as provided in
32 this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level of fund
33 balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any proposed
34 expenditures would cause the DNA Detection fund to decline below six thousand
35 one hundred twenty seven dollars (\$6,127), the disbursing officer shall
36 immediately notify the executive head of the agency. Prior to any

1 obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency head shall file
2 written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting
3 approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall provide sufficient
4 financial data to justify the expenditures and shall include the following:

- 5 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such
6 expenditures on the fund balance.
- 7 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut
8 or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance.
- 9 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs
10 or one-time purchase of capitalized items.
- 11 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not
12 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent
13 depletion of the fund balance.

14 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and
15 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought
16 prior review by the Legislative Council.

17 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
18 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

19
20 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
21 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
22 PROVISION. Upon seeking and receiving approval from the Chief Fiscal Officer
23 of the State and review and approval by the Arkansas Legislative Council or
24 Joint Budget Committee, the Director of the State Crime Laboratory is
25 authorized to transfer appropriation from any line item authorized in the
26 State Operations Section of this Act to any line item authorized in the Hope
27 Drug Lab Operations Section of this Act.

28 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
29 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
30 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
31 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and

9 SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
10 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
11 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
12 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
13 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
14 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
15 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
16 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
17 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

18
19 SECTION 12. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
20 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
21 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
22 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
23 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
24 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
25 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
26 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

27
28 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
29 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
30 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
31 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
32 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
33 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
34 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
35 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
36 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

1 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
2 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
