21 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. YOUTH SERVICES - COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS - RESTRICTIONS. The 23 24 Department of Human Services shall not contract or pay for community-based residential programs within any municipality to house unrelated persons who 25 26 have been adjudicated delinquent of an act that would constitute a Class A 27 felony or higher or of a sexual offense or convicted of a Class A felony or 28 higher or sexual offense until the following conditions have been met: 29 1. Residents within one thousand (1,000) feet of the proposed location of the 30 facility shall be notified by mail;

31 2. A public hearing shall be conducted in the community of the proposed 32 location of the facility by the contract provider at least ten (10) days in 33 advance of the contract's effective date. Notice of the hearing shall be 34 made by mail to each of the residents within 1,000 feet of the proposed 35 location of the facility. TRANSFER 26 OF FUNDS FOR LOCAL JUVENILE DETENTION FACILITIES. The Chief Fiscal Officer 27 of the State shall transfer funds in an amount of \$400,000 for each fiscal 28 year of the biennial period ending June 30, 2005 2007 from the Department of 29 Human Services - Youth Services Fund Account to the Juvenile Detention 30 Facilities Operating Fund to fund the appropriation to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer for grants for operating 31 32 expenses of local juvenile detention facilities.

SECTION 11. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. 23 SECTION 13. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 24 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 25 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of 26 27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 28 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 29 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the 30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 31 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005. 34 35
