21 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. YOUTH SERVICES - COMMUNITY-BASED RESIDENTIAL PROGRAMS - RESTRICTIONS. The 23 24 Department of Human Services shall not contract or pay for community-based residential programs within any municipality to house unrelated persons who 25 26 have been adjudicated delinquent of an act that would constitute a Class A 27 felony or higher or of a sexual offense or convicted of a Class A felony or 28 higher or sexual offense until the following conditions have been met: 29 1. Residents within one thousand (1,000) feet of the proposed location of the 30 facility shall be notified by mail;
