12 (1) The voter identifies himself <u>or herself</u> by stating his <u>or</u>
13 <u>her</u> name and date of birth and is verified by the county clerk as a
14 registered voter within the county and, if the county is divided into more
15 than one (1) congressional district, within the same congressional district;

16 (2) The voter gives and affirms his <u>or her</u> current residence and

(1) An election official at the polling place shall notify the

31 (2) The individual shall be permitted to cast a provisional 32 ballot at that polling place upon the execution of a written affirmation by 33 the individual before an election official at the polling place stating that 34 the individual is:

35 (A) A registered voter in the jurisdiction precinct in
36 which the individual desires to vote; and

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(B) Eligible to vote in that election; (3) The provisional ballot shall be counted only upon verification of the voter's registration status in the precinct by the county board of election commissioners before certification of the election; and (4)(A) Whenever a person casts a provisional ballot, the election official shall provide the voter written information that states that the individual who casts a provisional ballot will be able to ascertain whether the vote was counted, and if not, the reason the vote was not counted, by accessing a toll-free telephone number, Internet website, or other free access system established by the Secretary of State for that purpose. (B) Access to information about an individual provisional ballot shall be restricted to the individual who cast the ballot. (c) The election official shall indicate on the list of voters those persons who vote under these circumstances make a list of all voters who cast a provisional ballot.
