24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
25

26 *SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for*
27 *the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council for the 2005-*
28 *2007 biennium, the following maximum number of regular employees, the grades*
29 *to be assigned to the respective positions, and the maximum annual salaries*
30 *for each such position. The maximum annual salary for the position assigned*
31 *to grades shall be determined in accordance with, but shall not exceed the*
32 *maximum annual amount for the grade assigned herein, as established in*
33 *Arkansas Code 21-5-209. Except for the purpose of determining the maximum*
34 *annual salary rate, which is to be applicable to each of the positions to*
35 *which a salary grade is assigned hereinafter, in accordance with the*
36 *provisions of Arkansas Code 21-5-209, all positions set forth herein shall be*



1 exempt from other provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation
 2 Act, or its successor, but shall not be exempt from the provisions of the
 3 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act, or its successor.

SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. There is hereby authorized, for the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: twenty-five (25) temporary or part-time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this act for the appropriate classification.

21 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
 23 PROVISION. Any unexpended balance of any appropriation provided in this Act
 24 which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2004~~ 2006,
 25 shall be transferred forward and made available for the same purpose for the
 26 fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007. In the event that unforeseen
 27 circumstances arise during the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2004~~ 2006 such
 28 that any appropriations made available for that year are insufficient, the
 29 Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research of the Legislative Council
 30 shall certify the amount thereof to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State,
 31 who upon receipt of the certification, shall transfer the amount so certified
 32 from the appropriation authorized for the fiscal year ending June 30, ~~2005~~
 33 2007 to the appropriate appropriations for the fiscal year ending June 30,

1 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
3 PROVISION - LINE ITEMS. The Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research
4 is hereby authorized to direct the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State to
5 transfer appropriation between line items within appropriations and also
6 between the appropriations made by this Act in such amounts as determined
7 necessary in either fiscal year of the ~~2003-05~~ 2005-07 biennium. The
8 provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005
9 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

10
11 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
12 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
13 CONTINGENCY POSITIONS - RESTRICTIONS. The positions authorized as
14 Contingency in this Act shall be filled only in the event that programs are
15 required to be implemented that were not contemplated at the time of the
16 submission by the Bureau of Legislative Research of its ~~2003-05~~ 2005-07
17 biennial budget request to the Arkansas Legislative Council. The provisions
18 of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005 through June
19 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

20
21 SECTION 10. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. SENIOR
23 CAREER SERVICE POSITIONS. The positions authorized in this Act as "Senior
24 Career Service Positions" shall be utilized only for those incumbents on June
25 30, 1997 who would otherwise be unable to obtain the pay increases approved
26 by the Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research due to the exceptional
27 tenure and circumstances of the incumbents. In the event that the employee
28 being paid from a "Senior Career Service Position" is no longer employed by
29 the Bureau of Legislative Research, the position shall remain vacant. As
30 long as any "Senior Career Service Position" is filled, a position with the
31 same title authorized as a regular employee in Section 1 shall not be filled.

32
33 SECTION 11. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
34 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. COST OF
35 LIVING INCREASES. Employees of the Bureau of Legislative Research assigned
36 to positions having a labor grade shall be eligible for cost-of-living

1 increases on July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005 and July 1, ~~2004~~ 2006 in an amount equal to
2 that granted to all other state agency, board, commission or institution of
3 higher education employees on those dates. Any additional adjustments in
4 annual salary rates for Bureau employees, labor market adjustments, merit pay
5 adjustments or employee retention or recruitment requirements shall be made
6 at the discretion of the Director of the Bureau.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~
8 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

9
10 SECTION 12. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
12 DISBURSING OFFICER. The Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research of the
13 Legislative Council shall be the disbursing officer for the funds
14 appropriated by this Act, including the Interim Committee Study Expenses and
15 all expenditures from the appropriations provided by this Act shall be in
16 accordance with procedures established by the Legislative Council and in
17 accordance with appropriate law.

18 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~
19 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

20
21 SECTION 13. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
22 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW.
23 PERFORMANCE REWARDS. The Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research may
24 implement a program to reward employees of the bureau for exceptional service
25 similar to the state Career Ladder Incentive Plan bonus program authorized by
26 Arkansas Code 21-5-1101. The plan shall be approved by the Legislative
27 Council prior to its implementation. The provisions of this section shall be
28 in effect only from July 1, ~~2003~~ 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

29
30 SECTION 14. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code § 10-2-215 is amended to
31 read as follows:

32 *10-2-215. Additional compensation for committee chairs and cochairs.*

33 *(a) In addition to the expense allowance provided by § 10-2-212 and all*
34 *laws amendatory and supplemental thereto, the chair of each of the standing,*
35 *select, and joint committees of either house of the General Assembly, the*
36 *cochairs of the Legislative Council and the cochairs of the Legislative Joint*

1 Auditing Committee, the Speaker Designate of the House of Representatives,
2 the House chairs of the Review/PEER Subcommittee, ~~and~~ the Personnel
3 Subcommittee, the Claims Subcommittee, and the Special Language Subcommittee
4 of the Joint Budget Committee, and the cochair of any committee of the
5 General Assembly which does not function during the legislative session shall
6 be eligible to receive an additional two thousand four hundred dollars
7 (\$2,400) per year and the chair of each subcommittee of each standing
8 committee of either house shall be eligible to receive an additional one
9 thousand two hundred dollars (\$1,200) per year.

10 (b) This additional allowance shall be paid from the same funds and
11 appropriation and in the same manner as provided for the allowances
12 authorized by § 10-2-212 and all laws amendatory and supplemental thereto.
13

14 SECTION 15. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code § 10-3-301(g), concerning
15 subcommittees of the Joint Budget Committee, is amended to read as follows:

16 (g) The House chairs and vice chairs of the Review/PEER Subcommittee, ~~and~~
17 the Personnel Subcommittee, and the Claims Subcommittee of the Joint Budget
18 Committee shall serve on the corresponding subcommittees of the Legislative
19 Council as ex officio nonvoting members.
20

21 SECTION 16. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code § 10-3-502, concerning the
22 membership of the Legislative Council, is amended to read as follows:

23 (d) The chairs of the Personnel Subcommittee, the Review Subcommittee,
24 ~~and~~ the Performance Evaluation and Expenditure Review Subcommittee, and
25 Claims Subcommittee of the Legislative Council shall serve as ex officio
26 nonvoting members of the corresponding Joint Budget Committee subcommittees.
27

28 SECTION 17. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code § 10-3-507, concerning
29 presession budget hearings, is amended to add an additional subsection to
30 read as follows:

31 (d) The House chair of the Special Language Subcommittee of the Joint
32 Budget Committee shall serve on the corresponding subcommittee of the
33 Legislative Council/Joint Budget Committee presession budget hearings as ex
34 officio nonvoting members.
35

36 SECTION 18. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. Arkansas Code § 10-3-303, concerning the

1 Bureau of Legislative Research, is amended to add an additional subsection to
2 read as follows:

3 (f)(1) There is established the Executive Subcommittee of the Arkansas
4 Legislative Council to be composed of the following members:

5 (A) The House and Senate cochairs of the Arkansas Legislative
6 Council;

7 (B) The House and Senate vice chairs of the Arkansas Legislative
8 Council;

9 (C) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate or one (1) Senator
10 selected by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;

11 (D) The Speaker of the House of Representatives or one (1)
12 Representative selected by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

13 (E) Immediate past Senate Chair of the Arkansas Legislative Council
14 or one (1) member designate appointed by the Senate chair of the Arkansas
15 Legislative Council; and

16 (F) Immediate past House Chair of the Arkansas Legislative Council
17 or one (1) member designate appointed by the House chair of the Arkansas
18 Legislative Council.

19 (g) The Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research shall report to
20 and regularly seek the review and advice of the Executive Subcommittee prior
21 to taking:

22 (1) Actions regarding establishing new, repealing, or changing
23 personnel policies pertaining to employees of the Bureau of Legislative
24 Research;

25 (2)(A) Actions concerning the hiring or termination of staff, staff
26 promotions, and proposed salary changes;

27 (B) Nothing in this section shall be construed to create an
28 employment contract, any salary obligation, other obligation, or change in
29 employment status of staff of the Bureau of Legislative Research from an at-
30 will employment relationship.

31 (3) Establishing new, repealing, or changing any other policies or
32 procedures of the Bureau of Legislative Research relating to the delivery of
33 services and other matters pertaining to the operation of the Bureau of
34 Legislative Research, including the biennial budget request of the Bureau of
35 Legislative Research.

36

1 SECTION 19. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
2 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. AD HOC
3 EMPLOYEE PAY PLAN AND CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM STUDY COMMITTEE. The two Co-
4 Chairs of the Personnel/Pay Plan Subcommittee of the Joint Budget Committee
5 of the 85th General Assembly, together with one other member of the
6 Personnel/Pay Plan Subcommittee appointed by the President Pro Tem of the
7 Senate and one other member of the Personnel/Pay Plan Subcommittee appointed
8 by the Speaker of the House of Representatives, shall constitute a committee
9 to be known as the Ad Hoc Employee Pay Plan and Classification System Study
10 Committee.

11
12 The Ad Hoc Employee Pay Plan and Classification System Study Committee
13 shall participate with the Office of Personnel Management of the Department
14 of Finance and Administration and the Bureau of Legislative Research in the
15 study to revise the Classification and Compensation Plan required by Act 1015
16 of 2005.

17
18 The members of the Ad Hoc Employee Pay Plan and Classification System
19 Study Committee shall serve as ex-officio members of the Uniform Personnel
20 Classification and Compensation Plan Subcommittee of the Arkansas Legislative
21 Council.

22
23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2005
24 through December 31, 2006.

25
26 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
27 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
28 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
29 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
30 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
31 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
32 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
33 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
34 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

35
36 SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly

1 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
2 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
3 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
4 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
5 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
6 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
7 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

8
9 SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
10 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
11 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
12 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
13 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
14 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
15 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
16 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
17 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
