15	AN ACT TO AMEND § 15-21-503 CONCERNING	
16	THE ARKANSAS STATE LAND INFORMATION

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20	BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:	
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22	SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 15-21-503 is amended to read as follows	:
23	15-21-503. Creation - Board.	
24	(a) The Arkansas State Land Information Board is created.	
25	(b)(1)(A) The board shall be composed of twelve (12) voting member	s
26	appointed by the Governor for terms of four (4) years.	
27	(B) At the time of appointment or reappointment, the	
28	appointing authority shall adjust the length of terms to ensure that the	
29	terms of members of the board are staggered so that, insofar as possible,	an
30	equal number of members shall rotate each year.	
31	(2) The board shall be composed of the following members or	
32	their designees:	
33	(A) Three (3) state entity representatives;	
34 35	(B) Three (3) city, county, and local government	
35 36	representatives; (C) Three (3) private sector representatives; and	
50	(o) Three (b) private sector representatives; and	

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- 1 (D) Three (3) representatives of institutions of higher
- 2 education.
- 3 (3) All members of the board shall have knowledge of the use and
- 4 usefulness of digital land and geographic information in the management of
- 5 government and a general awareness of the role of mapping as related to that
- 6 management.
- 7 (4) With the exception of those members appointed to the board
- 8 representing a state agency, no No person shall serve as a member of the
- 9 board for more than two (2) <u>full</u> consecutive terms.
- 10 (5) Upon the death, disability, resignation, removal, or refusal
- 11 to serve of any member, the Governor shall appoint a qualified person to
- 12 complete board membership.
- 13 (c)(1)(A) A chair and a vice chair shall be elected by the board
- 14 membership to oversee all board and committee meetings.
- 15 (B) Members of the board must elect a chair and vice chair
- 16 every year.
- 17 (2)(A) The board will work with the State Geographic Information
- 18 Coordinator assigned by the State Executive Chief Information Officer with
- 19 approval from the board.
- 20 (B) The State Geographic Information Coordinator will:
- 21 (i) Assist the board in developing a comprehensive
- 22 plan and evaluation procedures on how the state should implement tactical and
- 23 strategic geographic information systems and land information systems
- 24 planning;
- 25 (ii) Implement informational and educational
- 26 programs; and
- 27 (iii) Coordinate intrastate geographic information
- 28 systems and land information systems efforts.
- 29 (C) The State Geographic Information Coordinator shall
- 30 report directly to the State Executive Chief Information Officer.
- 31 (d)(1) The State Geographic Information Coordinator shall administer
- 32 daily operations of the Arkansas Geographic Information Office with direction
- 33 from the board.
- 34 (2) This may include liaison between the board and the Governor,
- 35 the State Executive Chief Information Officer, and public or private sector
- 36 entities involved in spatial data and land records modernization, project

1	management in the preparation of the strategic planning documents related to
2	spatial data and land records modernization, developing policy and procedures
3	for land records modernization, and developing policy and procedures for the
4	activities of the board.
5	(3) Additional requirements are the implementation of
6	educational programs, coordinating vendor exhibits, and facilitating
7	technical assistance and consulting.
8	(e) The board may identify and determine strategies that may lead to
9	acquiring a State Geodetic Advisor.
10	(f)(e) The board may conduct meetings at such places and such times as
11	it may deem necessary or convenient to enable it to exercise fully and
12	effectively its powers, perform its duties, and accomplish its objectives and
13	purposes.
14	(g)(f) Members of the board shall receive no compensation for their
15	services.
16	$\frac{h}{g}$ The board will be provided administrative support through the
17	Department of Information Systems. One (1) of the three (3) state entity
18	representatives shall be a department employee as recommended by the Director
19	of the Department of Information Systems Office of Information Technology.
20	(i)(h) The funds necessary to carry out the provisions of this
21	subchapter shall come from the Geographic Information Systems Fund.
22	(j)(i) The board shall seek the review and advice of the Joint
23	Committee on Advanced Communications and Information Technology prior to
24	issuing guidelines, proposed legislation, and strategic plans.
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
