Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, there to be used solely for the
operations and support of the State Crime Laboratory.
(ii) These moneys shall be in addition to all other
sources of funding for the State Crime Laboratory and shall not be used to
supplant any other source of funding for the State Crime Laboratory.
