21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
22

23 SECTION 1. REAPPROPRIATION - HENDERSON STATE UNIVERSITY - GENERAL
24 IMPROVEMENT. There is hereby appropriated, to the Henderson State University,
25 to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund
26 accounts, for the Henderson State University, the following:

27 (A) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in
28 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 349 of 2003, for construction and equipping of a
29 Henderson State University School of Business Building, in a sum not to
30 exceed\$13,580.
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32 (B) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in
33 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1125 of 2003, for equipping and operation of the
34 Technology Learning Center, in a sum not to exceed\$44,982.
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36 (C) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in



1 Item (A) of Section 3 of Act 626 of 2003, for critical

21 (H) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in

23 a sum not to exceed\$25,000.

25 (I) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in
26 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 391 of 2003, for the Northeast Arkansas Fire
27 Training Satellite Center for maintenance and operating expenses, in a sum
28 not to exceed\$24,430.

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30 SECTION 4. REAPPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS STATE UNIVERSITY - BEEBE. There is
31 hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas State University - Beebe, to be payable
32 from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for
33 the Arkansas State University - Beebe, the following:

35 Item (A) of Section 7 of Act 137 of 2003, for construction, renovation, major
36 maintenance, and purchase of equipment for various capital projects or

1 facility improvements, in a sum not to exceed\$50,956.

4 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 630 of 2003, for institutional facilities and
5 improvements, in a sum not to exceed\$339,000.

9 maintenance/equipment/library resources for the Division of Agriculture, in a

4 SECTION 46. REAPPROPRIATION - DEPARTMENT OF HIGHER EDUCATION. There is
5 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Higher Education, to be payable
6 from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, for
7 the Department of Higher Education, the following:

8 (A) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in
9 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 572 of 2003, for grant(s) for the operational
10 costs of the Arkansas Association of Two-Year Colleges Workforce Training
11 Consortium (WFTC), in a sum not to exceed\$118,450.

12
13 (B) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in
14 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 1258 of 2003, for operations of the Technical
15 Institute Study Commission, in a sum not to exceed\$49,454.

16
17 (C) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in
18 Item (A) of Section 1 of Act 972 of 2003, for grants for the operational
19 costs of the Career Assessment Consortium of the Arkansas Association of Two
20 Year Colleges, in a sum not to exceed\$59,975.

21
22 SECTION 47. REAPPROPRIATION - COLLEGE SAVINGS BOND PROGRAM. There is
23 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Higher Education, to be payable
24 from the Higher Education Projects Development Fund, for the Department of
25 Higher Education, the following:

26 (A) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in
27 Item (A) of Section 41 of Act 349 of 2003, for the development of projects at
28 State Institutions of Higher Education and the payment of project costs and
29 expenses of the issuance of bonds of the Arkansas College Savings General
30 Obligation Bonds Program, in a sum not to exceed\$121,602.

31
32 (B) Effective July 1, 2005, the balance of the appropriation provided in
33 Item (B) of Section 41 of Act 349 of 2003, for the development of projects at
34 State Institutions of Higher Education and the payment of project costs and
35 expenses of the issuance of bonds of the Arkansas College Savings General
36 Obligation Bonds Program, in a sum not to exceed\$3,485,740.

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SECTION 48. DISBURSEMENT CONTROLS. (A) No contract may be awarded nor obligations otherwise incurred in relation to the project or projects described herein in excess of the State Treasury funds actually available therefor as provided by law. Provided, however, that institutions and agencies listed herein shall have the authority to accept and use grants and donations including Federal funds, and to use its unobligated cash income or funds, or both available to it, for the purpose of supplementing the State Treasury funds for financing the entire costs of the project or projects enumerated herein. Provided further, that the appropriations and funds otherwise provided by the General Assembly for Maintenance and General Operations of the agency or institutions receiving appropriation herein shall not be used for any of the purposes as appropriated in this act.

(B) The restrictions of any applicable provisions of the State Purchasing Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law and any other applicable fiscal control laws of this State and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of any funds provided by this act unless specifically provided otherwise by law.

SECTION 49. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 50. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that previous General Assemblies have provided appropriations for the projects provided or enumerated in this act; that certain appropriations will expire before the adjournment of the General Assembly; and that if such appropriations expire, the projects and programs authorized herein will cease thereby depriving the

1 citizens of the State of the benefits to be derived from such projects.
2 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
3 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
4 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its
5 passage and approval.

6 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
7 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
8 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
9 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
10 the veto.

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
