## For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR OPERATING  
10 EXPENSES, REFUNDS, AND CLAIMS FOR THE ARKANSAS  
11 MANUFACTURED HOME COMMISSION WHICH SHALL BE  
12 SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS  
13 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 44 OF 2003; AND FOR OTHER  
14 PURPOSES.

17 AN ACT FOR THE ARKANSAS MANUFACTURED  
18 HOME COMMISSION SUPPLEMENTAL  
19 APPROPRIATION.

23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
24

25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - OPERATING EXPENSES, REFUNDS, AND CLAIMS. There  
26 is hereby appropriated, to the Arkansas Manufactured Home Commission, to be  
27 payable from the Manufactured Housing Recovery Fund, for operating expenses,  
28 refunds, and claims of the Arkansas Manufactured Home Commission which shall  
29 be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 3 of  
30 Act 44 of 2003, the following:

8 SECTION 2. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
10 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
11 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
13 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
14 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

17

18 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
20 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act  
21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
25 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

27 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
28 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of  
29 the Arkansas Manufactured Home Commission are, due to unforeseen  
30 circumstances, insufficient for the Arkansas Manufactured Home Commission to  
31 continue to provide essential governmental services; that the provisions of  
32 this act will provide the necessary monies for the Arkansas Manufactured Home  
33 Commission to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date  
34 of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and  
35 provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is  
36 hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate

1 preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force  
2 and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

3 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
4 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor  
5 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
6 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides  
7 the veto.
