     diem of two hundred and fifty dollars ($250.00) for each day the General

        SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
     CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. PAYMENT

     OF SALARIES AND PER DIEM. Salaries and per diem as authorized in Section 1

     and 3 of this Act shall be in effect from and after January 10, 2005.

        SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
36
     by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
```

1 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 2 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 3 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 4 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 5 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 6 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 7 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 8 9 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 10 11 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 12 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 13 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 14 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 15 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 16 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 17 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 18 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 19 20 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 21 effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is 22 essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this 23 Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular 24 Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its 25 passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper 26 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, 27 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the 28 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in 29 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. 30 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor 31 32 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is 33 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides 34 the veto.
