SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 12 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged 13 14 with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the 15 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief 16 Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 17 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during 18 19 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the 20 21 President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon 22 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal 23 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board 24 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year. 25 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 26 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 27 28 SECTION 8. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 29 30 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 31 32 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 33 Procedures and Restrictions Act, the Higher Education Expenditures 34 Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this 35 State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied 36

3	SECTION 9. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
4	that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained

7	and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
8	the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral

12	SECTION 10. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
13	Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
14	appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
15	effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
16	the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
17	the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
18	date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
19	proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
20	Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
21	necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
22	safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
