15 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 17 BALANCES. The Board of Trustees in its official governing capacity charged with the management or control of the institution of higher learning and the 18 19 President or Chancellor as the Chief Executive shall certify to the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and the Legislative Council that as of December 20 21 31 of each year that sufficient appropriations and funds are available, or 22 will become available, to meet all current and anticipated obligations during 23 the fiscal year for the payment of the obligations when they become due. 24 This certification, signed by the Chair of the Board of Trustees and the President or Chancellor will be forwarded by February 28 of each year or upon 25 26 release of the previous year's audit by Legislative Audit to the Chief Fiscal 27 Officer of the State and the Legislative Council accompanied by the Board 28 approved published annual financial statement for the preceding fiscal year. 29 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 30 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

32 SECTION 7. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 33 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 34 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 35 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 36 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary

16 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 17 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 18 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of 19 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 20 21 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 22 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the 23 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 24 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 25 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 26 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005. 27 28 */s/ Joint Budget Committee* 29
