29	Attendance and Leave Policy Act, § 21-4-201 et seq., during the period that				
30	an employee of a state agency or institution of higher education is called to				
31	active duty after September 11, 2001, as a member of the National Guard or				
32	any of the reserve components of the armed forces by order of the President

34	(30) consecutive days, the employee shall be eligible for continued				
35	proportionate salary payments which, when combined with the employee's active

7	SECTION 2. (a) Notwithstanding any other law, during the period that		
8	an employee of a public school district is called to active duty after		
9	September 11, 2001, as a member of the National Guard or any of the reserve		
10	components of the armed forces by order of the President or the Governor of		
11	an emergency nature or contingency for more than thirty (30) consecutive		
12	days, the employee shall be eligible for continued proportionate salary		
13	payments which, when combined with the employee's active duty pay, equal the		
14	amount that the employee would have otherwise received but for the employee's		
15	required active duty under the order of the President or the Governor.		
16	(b) The Department of Education shall establish appropriate procedures		
17	for the administration of this section.

19	SECTION 3. <u>Definitions.</u>		
20	As used in this act:		
21	(1) "Emergency nature or contingency" means:		
22	(A) Any case or imminent danger of invasion, disaster,		
23	insurrection, riot, or breach of peace;		
24	(B) Threats to the public health or security; or		
25	(C) Threats to the maintenance of law and order; and		
26	(2) "State agency" includes the Arkansas Highway and		
27	Transportation Department, the Arkansas Game and Fish Commission, and the		
28	State Highway Commission.
