3	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 14-359-105, concerning the composition of a		
4	municipal airport commission, is amended to add a new subsection to read as		
5	follows:		
6	(e) For municipal airport commissions with five (5) members in		
7	existence on the effective date of this subsection (e), the initial terms of		
8	the two (2) new members shall be as follows:		
9	(1) One (1) new member shall serve an initial term of four (4)		
10	years; and		
11	(2) One (1) new member shall serve an initial term of five (5)		
12	years.

14	SECTION 3. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the		
15	General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that membership of a municipal		
16	airport commission in larger Arkansas cities is unnecessarily restricted;		
17	that increasing the number of commission members to that of commissions in		
18	smaller cities will better equip the commission to address the needs of the		
19	municipal airports; and that this act is immediately necessary in order to		
20	permit municipal airport commissions to begin the process of selecting		
21	additional members. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this act		
22	being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health		
23	and safety shall become effective on:		
24	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
25	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
26	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the		
27	bill; or		
28	(3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is		
29	overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
