19 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
20

21 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 16-21-129 is amended to read as follows:
22 16-21-129. The Ninth Judicial District-East.

23 The Ninth Judicial District-East shall be a Division ~~B~~ A Judicial
24 District.

26 SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the
27 General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that the workload of the Ninth
28 Judicial District-East is burdensome; that the prosecuting attorney for the
29 Ninth Judicial District-East should be employed on a full-time basis; that
30 this act is indispensable to ensure the efficient administration of justice
31 in the Ninth Judicial District-East. Therefore, an emergency is declared to
32 exist and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the
33 public peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

34 (1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

35 (2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,
36 the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the



1 bill; or

2 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
3 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
