3	hauled by vehicles, a person who is hauling a load in a vehicle on a paved		
4	public street or highway shall:		
5	(1) Securely fasten the load;		
6	(2) Cover the load; and		
7	(3) Securely fasten the cover on the load.		
8	(d) A person who violates subsection (b) or (c) of this section is		
9	guilty of a Class C misdemeanor.		
10	(e) This section shall not apply to the following:		
11	(1) The necessary spreading of any substance by a highway		
12	maintenance or construction vehicle; or		
13	(2)(A) A trailer or semitrailer that is hauling livestock if:		
14	(i) The trailer or semitrailer is properly equipped		
15	with a cleanout trap; and		
16	(ii) The trap is operated in a closed position.		
17	(B) All trailers or semitrailers used for hauling		
18	livestock shall be cleaned periodically.

20	SECTION 2. Arkansas Code § 27-35-110 is repealed.		
21	27-35-110. Spilling loads on highways prohibited - Covers required for		
22	loads of sand, gravel, and rock - Exceptions.		
23	(a) No vehicle shall be driven or moved on any highway unless the		
24	vehicle is so constructed or loaded as to prevent any of its load from		
25	dropping, sifting, leaking, or otherwise escaping therefrom.		
26	(b) Sand may be dropped for the purpose of securing traction, or water		
27	or other substance may be sprinkled on a roadway in cleaning or maintaining		
28	the roadway.		
29	(c) For a motor vehicle or a trailer with an open bed manufactured		
30	after September 30, 2001, no sand, gravel, or rock shall be transported on		
31	the paved public streets and highways of this state in a motor vehicle or		
32	trailer with an open bed unless the open bed is securely covered with a		
33	material which will prevent the load from dropping, sifting, leaking, or		
34	otherwise escaping therefrom. The cover shall be securely fastened to preven		
35	the covering from becoming loose, detached, or in any manner a hazard to		
36	other users of the highway.

           (d) For a motor vehicle or a trailer with an open bed manufactured on
 2
     or before September 30, 2001, a vehicle with an open bed transporting sand,
 3
     gravel, or rock is required to be covered as prescribed in subsection (c) of
 4
     this section unless six inches (6") of freeboard is maintained at the
 5
     perimeter of the load within the open bed of the vehicle or trailer carrying
 6
     the load. Measurements are to be taken at the perimeter of the vehicle's or
 7
     trailer's bed and measured from the top edge of the bed down to the sand,
 8
     gravel, or rock being transported.
