13 TO REQUIRE LOADS HAULED BY VEHICLES TO

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

19 *SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 27-35-110 is amended to read as follows:*

20 *27-35-110. Spilling loads on highways prohibited - Covers required for*  
21 *loads of sand, gravel, and rock - Exceptions.*

22 *(a) For the purposes of this section:*

23 *(1) "Cover" means a cloth, rubber, plastic, polymer, or metal*  
24 *device designed or used to cover a load hauled by a vehicle;*

25 *(2) "Load" means any material or substance that is hauled:*

26 *(A) In a vehicle that is not enclosed on all sides of the*  
27 *vehicle; or*

28 *(B) By a vehicle in a trailer or towing device that has*  
29 *any unenclosed areas; and*

30 *(3) "Vehicle" means every device in, upon, or by which any*  
31 *person or property is, or may be, transported or drawn upon a highway,*  
32 *excepting devices moved by human power or used exclusively upon stationary*  
33 *rails or tracks.*

34 *(b) No vehicle shall be driven or moved on any highway unless the*  
35 *vehicle is so constructed, covered, or loaded as to prevent any of its load*  
36 *from dropping, sifting, leaking, or otherwise escaping therefrom.*
