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26 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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28 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATIONS - FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN LOGAN COUNTY. There is  
29 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -  
30 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its  
31 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

32 (A) For state support to the Blue Mountain Rural Fire Department in Logan  
33 County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

34 (B) For state support to the Delaware Rural Fire Department in Logan

(D) For state support to the Midway Rural Fire Department in Logan County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

(F) For state support to the Corley Fire Department in Logan County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS - FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN POPE COUNTY. There is hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

(A) For state support to the Russellville Fire Department #2 in Pope County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

(B) For state support to the Russellville Fire Department #3 in Pope County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

(C) For state support to the Russellville Fire Department #4 in Pope County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

(D) For state support to the Crow Mountain Fire Department in Pope County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

(E) For state support to the Russellville (Central) Fire Department in Pope County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

(F) For state support to the Moreland Rural Fire Department in Pope County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

(G) For state support to the City of Atkins Volunteer Fire Department in Pope County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

(H) For state support to the Bayliss Rural Volunteer Fire Department in Pope County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

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 10 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS - FIRE DEPARTMENTS IN YELL COUNTY. There is  
 11 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -  
 12 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the General Improvement Fund or its  
 13 successor fund or fund accounts, the following:

14 (A) For state support to the Bellville Fire Department in Yell County, the  
 15 sum of .....\$10,000.

16 (B) For state support to the Briggsville Volunteer Fire Department in Yell  
 17 County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

18 (C) For state support to the Danville Fire Department in Yell County, the  
 19 sum of .....\$10,000.

20 (D) For state support to the Galla Rock Rural Volunteer Fire Department in  
 21 Yell County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

22 (E) For state support to the Chickalah Rural Fire Department in Yell  
 23 County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

24 (F) For state support to the Dardanelle Rural Fire Department in Yell  
 25 County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

26 (G) For state support to the City of Dardanelle Fire Department in Yell  
 27 County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

28 (H) For state support to the Mount Nebo Rural Fire Department in Yell  
 29 County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

30 (I) For state support to the West Fourche Volunteer Fire Department in  
 31 Yell County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

32 (J) For state support to the Havana Fire Department in Yell County, the  
 33 sum of .....\$10,000.

34 (K) For state support to the Ola Fire Department in Yell County, the sum  
 35 of .....\$10,000.

36 (L) For state support to the Aly-Chula Volunteer Fire Department in Yell

County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

(M) For state support to the Plainview Fire Department in Yell County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

(N) For state support to the Rover Volunteer Fire Department in Yell County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

(O) For state support to the Dutch Creek Fire Department in Yell County, the sum of .....\$10,000.

SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being

necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and  
safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
