SENATE BILL 440

For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO ALLOW MEMBERSHIP OF A MUNICIPAL
PLANNING COMMISSION TO BE FILLED BY ELECTORS
LIVING OUTSIDE THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE
MUNICIPALITY BUT WITHIN THE PLANNING JURISDICTION
OF THE MUNICIPALITY; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

Subtitle

AN ACT TO ALLOW MEMBERSHIP OF A
MUNICIPAL PLANNING COMMISSION TO BE
FILLED BY ELECTORS LIVING OUTSIDE THE
CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE MUNICIPALITY BUT
WITHIN THE PLANNING JURISDICTION OF THE
MUNICIPALITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 14-56-405 is amended to read as follows:

14-56-405. Appointment of members.

(a) Appointment and terms of the members of the planning commission shall be as provided by city ordinance.

(b) The legislative body of the municipality may appoint one-third (1/3) of the membership of the planning commission from electors living outside the corporate limits of the municipality but within the recorded planning jurisdiction of the municipality.
