For An Act To Be Entitled

9 AN ACT TO PERMIT THE CREATION OF A POSITION FOR A
10 SCHOOL DISTRICT COORDINATOR FOR COUNTIES WITH SIX
11 (6) OR MORE SCHOOL DISTRICTS LOCATED IN THE
12 COUNTY; TO CREATE AN EXECUTIVE COUNCIL TO PROMOTE
13 COOPERATION AMONG THE VARIOUS SCHOOL DISTRICTS
14 LOCATED IN THE SAME COUNTY; AND FOR OTHER
15 PURPOSES.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

27 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code Title 6, Section 12, Chapter 3 is amended to
28 add sections to read as follows:

29 6-12-315. School district coordinator.

30 (a) Any county containing all or part of six (6) or more school
31 districts may create:

32 (1) An executive council; and

33 (2) The position of school district coordinator if a majority of
34 the school districts in the county pass a resolution requesting the creation
35 of the position of school district coordinator.

36 (b) The executive council may be made up of one (1) superintendent



1 from each school in the county and who may organize themselves in a manner to
 2 allow for meetings among superintendents in the county for the purpose of
 3 coordinating the business of the respective schools districts in a
 4 coordinated manner within the county.

5 (c) The school district coordinator may:

6 (1) Record the certificates of teachers as required by law;

7 (2) Be a representative of the State Board of Education and
 8 shall perform duties as may be required by the State Board of Education;

9 (3) Keep a record of the contracts made with teachers;

10 (4) Assume and perform all of the duties of the county board of
 11 education or county supervisor as in existence on January 1, 2005;

12 (5) Cooperate with the Department of Education in carrying out
 13 the budgetary regulations and procedures pertaining to school districts in
 14 the county as prescribed by the State Board of Education or by law;

15 (6) Keep in the school district coordinator's office and file
 16 with the Board of Trustees of the Arkansas Teacher Retirement System and the
 17 State Board of Education not later than October 15 of each year a list of all
 18 teachers employed in the county for the ensuing year, setting forth the type
 19 of certificate held by each teacher, the teacher's monthly contract salary,
 20 whether the teacher is a member of the system, and other information as the
 21 State Board of Education may deem necessary;

22 (7) Cause to be set aside from funds in the county general
 23 school fund amounts necessary for the expenses of the executive council; and

24 (8) Perform other duties related to the school districts in the
 25 county as may be requested by the executive council.

 27 6-12-317. Salary.

28 (a) Each executive council may determine the salary of the school
 29 district coordinator and allowances for travel, clerical support, and office
 30 and other expenses.

31 (b) The chair of the executive council may call a meeting in June each
 32 year for the consideration of these matters.

33 (c) All allowances for office expense, travel, and clerical support
 34 shall be based upon detailed budgets submitted by the school district
 35 coordinator and approved by the executive committee.

36 (d) With the approval of the executive council, the school district

1 coordinator is authorized to hire necessary clerical and other assistants.

2 (e) The allowances to the school district coordinator and members of
3 the executive committee for travel expense, meals, and hotels shall not be in
4 excess of the allowance for state employees.

5 (f)(1) The expense allowed under this section may be paid from the
6 unapportioned county general school fund to a special fund by the county
7 treasurer, or the common fund of the county or any other source.

8 (2) Payments allowed under this section shall be made only after
9 presentation of invoices, statements, itemized expense accounts, or payroll
10 vouchers signed by the school district coordinator and the chair of executive
11 council.
