Such a report shall include a concise statement of facts with an explanation 3 4 of the agency's liability. Provided further, such report shall be filed with 5 the Litigation Subcommittee within thirty (30) days after the claim has been 6 adjudicated by the State Claims Commission. 7 8 SECTION 20. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 9 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 10 11 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 12 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 13 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 14 15 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 16 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 17 18 SECTION 21. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 19 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 20 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 21 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 22 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 23 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 24 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 25 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 26 SECTION 22. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 27 28 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 29 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 30 effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this 31 32 Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular 33 Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its 34 passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper

administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the

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1	immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
2	full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
3	If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
4	effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
5	may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
6	overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides
7	the veto.
