7	lienholder or to an insurer because the lienholder or insurer succeeds in
8	ownership to the vehicle as a result of the accident.
9	(2) The data shall not be used by a lienholder or an insurer for
10	any reason without a written consent in the form of a release signed by the
11	owner of the motor vehicle at the time of the accident that authorizes the
12	lienholder or insurer to retrieve or use the data.
13	(3) A lienholder or insurer shall not make the owner's consent
14	to the retrieval or use of the data conditioned upon the payment or
15	settlement of an obligation or claim.
16	(f) Except as specifically provided under subsections (d), (g), and
17	(h) of this section, the data from a motor vehicle data recorder shall only
18	be produced without the consent of the owner at the time of the accident if:
19	(1) A court of competent jurisdiction in Arkansas orders the
20	production of the data;
21	(2) A law enforcement officer obtains the data based on probable
22	cause of an offense under the laws of the State of Arkansas; or
23	(3) A law enforcement officer, a firefighter, or an emergency
24	medical services provider obtains the data in the course of responding to or
25	investigating an emergency involving physical injury or the risk of physical
26	injury to any person.
27	(g) The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department may
28	obtain data from a motor vehicle data recorder if the data is used for the
29	following purposes:
30	(1) Preclearing weigh stations;
31	(2) Automating driver records of duty status as authorized by
32	the United States Department of Transportation;
33	(3) Replacing handwritten reports for any fuel tax reporting or
34	other mileage reporting purpose; or
35	(4) Complying with a state or federal law.
36	(h) To protect the public health, welfare, and safety, the following

1	exceptions shall be allowed regarding the use of data from a motor vehicle

3	(1) To determine the need or facilitate emergency medical care
4	for the driver or passenger of a motor vehicle that is involved in a motor
5	vehicle crash or other emergency, including obtaining data from a company
6	that provides subscription services to the owners of motor vehicles for in-

8	(2) To facilitate medical research of the human body's reaction
9	to motor vehicle crashes if:
10	(i) The identity of the owner or driver is not disclosed
11	in connection with the retrieved data; and
12	(ii) The last four (4) digits of the vehicle
13	identification number are not disclosed; or
14	(3) To diagnose, service, or repair a motor vehicle.
15	(i) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section, the use of
16	data from a motor vehicle data recorder shall not be permitted into evidence
17	in a civil or criminal matter pending before a court in the State of Arkansas
18	if the original manufacturer's warranty of the motor vehicle has expired.
