11	(b) A person who purchases a motor vehicle that is equipped with a	
12	motor vehicle data recorder shall be given written notice by the seller or	
13	manufacturer that includes the following:	
14	(1) The presence of the motor vehicle data recorder in the motor	
15	vehicle;	
16	(2) The type of motor vehicle data recorder in the motor	
17	vehicle; and	
18	(3) The type of data that is stored on the motor vehicle data	
19	recorder.	
20	(c) Except as otherwise provided in this section, the data on a motor	
21	vehicle data recorder:	
22	(1) Is private;	
23	(2) Is exclusively owned by the owner of the motor vehicle; and	
24	(3) Shall not be retrieved or used by another person or entity.	
25	(d)(1) If a motor vehicle is owned by one (1) owner, then the owner of	
26	a motor vehicle may provide written consent in the form of a release signed	
27	by the owner that authorizes a person or entity to retrieve or use the data.	
28	(2) If a motor vehicle is owned by more than one (1) person or	
29	entity and if all owners agree to release the data, then all owners must	
30	consent in writing by signing a release to authorize a person or entity to	
31	retrieve or use the data.	
32	(3) A release to a person or entity under this subsection shall	
33	be limited to permission for data collection and compilation only and shall	
34	not authorize the release of information that identifies the owner of the	
35	vehicle.	
36	(e)(1)(A) If a motor vehicle is equipped with a motor vehicle data	

1	recorder and is involved in an accident in Arkansas, the owner of the motor
2	vehicle at the time of the accident shall own and retain exclusive ownership
3	rights to the data.
4	(B) The ownership of the data shall not pass to a
5	lienholder or to an insurer because the lienholder or insurer succeeds in
6	ownership to the vehicle as a result of the accident.
7	(2) The data shall not be used by a lienholder or an insurer for
8	any reason without a written consent in the form of a release signed by the
9	owner of the motor vehicle at the time of the accident that authorizes the
10	lienholder or insurer to retrieve or use the data.
11	(3) A lienholder or insurer shall not make the owner's consent
12	to the retrieval or use of the data conditioned upon the payment or
13	settlement of an obligation or claim.
14	(f) Except as provided in subsection (g) of this section, the data
15	from a motor vehicle data recorder shall only be produced without the consent
16	of the owner at the time of the accident if a court of competent jurisdiction
17	in Arkansas orders the production of the data.
18	(g) The Arkansas State Highway and Transportation Department may
19	obtain data from a motor vehicle data recorder used for the following
20	purposes:
21	(1) Preclearing weigh stations;
22	(2) Automating driver records of duty status as authorized by
23	the United States Department of Transportation;
24	(3) Replacing handwritten reports for any fuel tax reporting or
25	other mileage reporting purpose; or
26	(4) Complying with a state or federal law.
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
