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15 AN ACT FOR THE STATE CHILD ABUSE AND
16 NEGLECT PREVENTION BOARD - ONE PERCENT
17 TO PREVENT APPROPRIATION.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - ONE PERCENT TO PREVENT. There is hereby
23 appropriated, to the State Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board, to be
24 payable from the One Percent To Prevent Fund, for providing services to the
25 children of incarcerated parents, the caregivers of those children and to the
26 incarcerated parents themselves through the One Percent to Prevent Program of
27 the State Child Abuse and Neglect Prevention Board, the sum of\$200,000.
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29 SECTION 2. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND
31 TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal
32 Officer of the State shall transfer on his or her books and those of the
33 State Treasurer and Auditor of the State the sum of two hundred thousand
34 dollars (\$200,000) from the General Revenue Allotment Reserve Fund to the One
35 Percent to Prevent Fund to provide funds for the One Percent to Prevent
36 appropriation authorized in this Act.



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2 SECTION 3. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
3 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
4 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
5 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
8 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
9 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
10 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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12 SECTION 4. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
13 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
14 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
15 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
16 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
17 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
18 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
19 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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21 SECTION 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
22 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
23 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
24 effectiveness of this Act on the date of its passage and approval is
25 essential to the operation of the agency for which the appropriations in this
26 Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular
27 Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond the date of its
28 passage and approval could work irreparable harm upon the proper
29 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,
30 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the
31 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in
32 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.
33 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become
34 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor
35 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is
36 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides

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
