**For An Act To Be Entitled**

9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR STATE'S  
10 CONTRIBUTIONS FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND  
11 ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER WHICH SHALL  
12 BE SUPPLEMENTAL AND IN ADDITION TO THOSE FUNDS  
13 APPROPRIATED BY ACT 50 OF THE FIRST EXTRAORDINARY  
14 SESSION OF 2003; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

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17 AN ACT FOR THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE  
18 AND ADMINISTRATION - DISBURSING OFFICER  
19 SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION.  
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:  
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25 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - STATE'S CONTRIBUTIONS. There is hereby  
26 appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing  
27 Officer, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, to pay  
28 the state's contributions for membership in various organizations which shall  
29 be supplemental and in addition to those funds appropriated in Section 1 of  
30 Act 50 of the First Extraordinary Session of 2003, the following:

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3 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - ARKANSAS WINE PRODUCERS COUNCIL. There is  
 4 hereby appropriated, to the Department of Finance and Administration -  
 5 Disbursing Officer, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund  
 6 Account, for payment of invoices of the Department of Finance and  
 7 Administration - Disbursing Officer which shall be supplemental and in  
 8 addition to those funds appropriated in Section 3 of Act 50 of the First  
 9 Extraordinary Session of 2003, the following:

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15 SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS  
 16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING  
 17 TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this Act, the Chief Fiscal  
 18 Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the State  
 19 Treasurer and Auditor of State the sum of twenty six thousand, five hundred  
 20 dollars (\$26,500) from the Federal Fiscal Relief Fund to the Miscellaneous  
 21 Agencies Fund Account to provide funds for the State's Contributions and  
 22 Arkansas Wine Producers Council appropriations authorized by this Act.

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24 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized  
 25 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds  
 26 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the  
 27 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and  
 28 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary  
 29 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal  
 30 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by  
 31 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be  
 32 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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34 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly  
 35 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained  
 36 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act

1 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations  
2 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by  
3 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral  
4 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or  
5 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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7 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General  
8 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of  
9 the Department of Finance and Administration - Disbursing Officer are, due to  
10 unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the Department of Finance and  
11 Administration - Disbursing Officer to continue to provide essential  
12 governmental services; that the provisions of this act will provide the  
13 necessary monies for the Department of Finance and Administration -  
14 Disbursing Officer to continue such services; and that a delay in the  
15 effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper  
16 administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore,  
17 an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the  
18 immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in  
19 full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval.

20 If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become  
21 effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor  
22 may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
23 overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides  
24 the veto.
