## For An Act To Be Entitled

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE SUNSET CLAUSE ON ACT 1366 OF  
2003, WHICH IS KNOWN AS THE HOMELAND SECURITY  
INFORMATION ACT; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

## Subtitle

AN ACT TO REPEAL THE SUNSET CLAUSE ON  
ACT 1366 OF 2003, WHICH IS KNOWN AS THE  
HOMELAND SECURITY INFORMATION ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

SECTION 1. Uncodified Section 4 of Act 1366 of 2003, concerning  
homeland security and threat assessment plans, is repealed:

~~Section 4. Sunset Clause.~~

~~This act expires on July 1, 2005.~~

SECTION 2. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the  
General Assembly of the State of Arkansas that Act 1366 of 2003, known as the  
Homeland Security Information Act, is necessary for the safety and protection  
of the citizens of the State of Arkansas, that without legislative action the  
Homeland Security Information Act will expire on July 1, 2005, and that this  
act is immediately necessary. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist  
and this act being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public  
peace, health, and safety shall become effective on:

(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;

(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,  
the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the



1 bill; or

2 (3) If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is  
3 overridden, the date the last house overrides the veto.
