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21 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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23 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - OPERATIONS. There is hereby established for
24 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission for the 2005-2007 biennium, the
25 following maximum number of regular employees whose salaries shall be
26 governed by the provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act
27 (Arkansas Code §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory
28 thereto. Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum
29 annual salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the
30 provisions of said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons
31 occupying positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions
32 of the Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-
33 101), or its successor.

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9 SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP. There is hereby authorized, for the Arkansas Code
 10 Revision Commission for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum number
 11 of part-time or temporary employees, to be known as "Extra Help", payable
 12 from funds appropriated herein for such purposes: six (6) temporary or part-
 13 time employees, when needed, at rates of pay not to exceed those provided in
 14 the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act, or its successor, or this
 15 act for the appropriate classification.

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17 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - OPERATIONS. There is hereby appropriated, to
 18 the Arkansas Code Revision Commission, to be payable from the Miscellaneous
 19 Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the
 20 Arkansas Code Revision Commission for the biennial period ending June 30,
 21 2007, the following:

36 SECTION 4. APPROPRIATION - BUDGET SAVINGS. There is hereby appropriated,

1 to the Arkansas Code Revision Commission, to be payable from revenues
2 collected and transferred to the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account to be
3 used exclusively by the Arkansas Code Revision Commission as set out in
4 Section 7 of this Act, for personal services and operating expenses of the
5 Arkansas Code Revision Commission, the sum of.....\$0.

6
7 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
8 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
9 AUTHORITY. The Arkansas Code Revision Commission may transfer appropriation
10 and funds as needed from the Budget Savings Appropriation in Section 4 to any
11 line item in the Operations Appropriation in Section 3 of this Act.

12 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
13 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

14
15 SECTION 6. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
16 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. TRANSFER
17 OF ALLOCATION. Funds allocated for the Arkansas Code Revision Commission
18 from the State Administration of Justice Fund shall be transferred or
19 deposited into the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account ~~State General Services~~
20 ~~Fund Account~~ to be used exclusively by the Arkansas Code Revision Commission
21 for the Arkansas Code Revision Commission, in lieu of transfer or deposit for
22 the Arkansas Code Revision Fund.

23 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
24 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

26 SECTION 7. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. BUDGET SAVINGS TRANSFER. (a) Due to
27 savings from receiving free sets of the Arkansas Code of 1987 Annotated, each
28 Agency or Officer shall transfer or deposit the following funds and
29 appropriations each fiscal year of the ~~2003-2005~~ 2005-2007 biennium to the

19 (b) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall make the necessary
 20 adjustments on his or her books and the books of the Auditor of the State for
 21 the transfer or deposit of the funds from each Officer or Agency as listed
 22 herein to Section 4 of this Act to the ~~State General Services~~ Miscellaneous
 23 Agencies Fund Account to be used exclusively by the Arkansas Code Revision
 24 Commission for each fiscal year of the ~~2003-2005~~ 2005-2007 biennium for the
 25 Arkansas Code Revision Commission.

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27 SECTION 8. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS
 28 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CODE
 29 REVISION COMMISSION OVERSIGHT.

30 (a) The Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research, or a Bureau
 31 employee designated by the Director, shall be the disbursing officer for the
 32 funds appropriated by this act.

33 (b) The Director, or a Bureau employee designated by the Director, shall
 34 maintain all personnel records of the Commission.

35 (c) When the Director contracts for an audit of the Bureau, he or she
 36 shall include in the contract a financial audit of the commission with a

1 proportional cost to be borne by the Commission except that the Bureau shall
2 bear the cost in excess of funds available to the Commission for that
3 purpose.

4 (d) By September 1st of each year, the Director, or a Bureau employee
5 designated by the Director, shall evaluate the staff of the Code Revision
6 Commission, reporting any problems to the Code Revision Commission.

7 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003
8 2005 through June 30, ~~2005~~ 2007.

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10 SECTION 9. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
11 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
12 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
13 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
14 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
15 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
16 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
17 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
18 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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20 SECTION 10. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
21 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
22 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
23 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
24 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
25 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
26 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
27 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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29 SECTION 11. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
30 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
31 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
32 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
33 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
34 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
35 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
36 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.

1 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
2 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
3 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.

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
