9 AN ACT TO MAKE AN APPROPRIATION FOR PERSONAL
10 SERVICES AND OPERATING EXPENSES FOR THE STATE
11 CRIME LABORATORY – MOUNTAIN HOME SATELLITE CRIME
12 LABORATORY FOR THE BIENNIAL PERIOD ENDING JUNE
13 30, 2007; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

16 AN ACT FOR THE STATE CRIME LABORATORY -
17 MOUNTAIN HOME SATELLITE CRIME LABORATORY
18 APPROPRIATION FOR THE 2005-2007
19 BIENNIUM.
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23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:

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25 SECTION 1. REGULAR SALARIES - MOUNTAIN HOME SATELLITE CRIME LABORATORY.
26 There is hereby established for the State Crime Laboratory – Mountain Home
27 Satellite Crime Laboratory for the 2005-2007 biennium, the following maximum
28 number of regular employees whose salaries shall be governed by the
29 provisions of the Uniform Classification and Compensation Act (Arkansas Code
30 §§21-5-201 et seq.), or its successor, and all laws amendatory thereto.
31 Provided, however, that any position to which a specific maximum annual
32 salary is set out herein in dollars, shall be exempt from the provisions of
33 said Uniform Classification and Compensation Act. All persons occupying
34 positions authorized herein are hereby governed by the provisions of the
35 Regular Salaries Procedures and Restrictions Act (Arkansas Code §21-5-101),
36 or its successor.

SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION - MOUNTAIN HOME SATELLITE CRIME LABORATORY. There is hereby appropriated, to the State Crime Laboratory, to be payable from the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account, for personal services and operating expenses of the State Crime Laboratory - Mountain Home Satellite Crime Laboratory for the biennial period ending June 30, 2007, the following:

SECTION 3. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUNDING TRANSFER. Immediately upon the effective date of this act, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall transfer on his books and those of the State Treasurer the sum of five hundred seventy eight thousand four hundred eighty-seven dollars (\$578,487) from the State Administration of Justice Fund to the Miscellaneous Agencies Fund Account as a direct revenue to provide funds

1 solely for the appropriations authorized herein for the biennial period
2 ending June 30, 2007.

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4 SECTION 4. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized
5 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
6 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
7 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and
8 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
9 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
10 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
11 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be
12 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

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14 SECTION 5. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
15 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
16 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
17 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
18 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
19 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
20 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
21 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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23 SECTION 6. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
24 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the
25 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the
26 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of
27 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in
28 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective
29 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the
30 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs.
31 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being
32 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and
33 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005.
