15 AN ACT CONCERNING THE EXECUTIVE
16 SUBCOMMITTEE OF THE ARKANSAS LEGISLATIVE
17 COUNCIL.
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20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ARKANSAS:
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22 SECTION 1. Arkansas Code § 10-3-303, concerning the Bureau of
23 Legislative Research, is amended to add an additional subsection to read as
24 follows:

25 (f)(1) There is established the Executive Subcommittee of the Arkansas
26 Legislative Council to be composed of the following members:

27 (A) The House and Senate cochairs of the Arkansas
28 Legislative Council;

29 (B) The House and Senate vice chairs of the Arkansas
30 Legislative Council;

31 (C) The President Pro Tempore of the Senate and one (1)
32 Senator selected by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate;

33 (D) The Speaker of the House of Representatives and one
34 (1) Representative selected by the Speaker of the House of Representatives;

35 (E) The chair of the Senate Efficiency Committee; and

36 (F) The chair of the House Management Committee.



1 (g) The Director of the Bureau of Legislative Research shall report to
2 and regularly seek the review and advice of the Executive Subcommittee prior
3 to taking:

4 (1) Actions regarding establishing new, repealing, or
5 changing personnel policies pertaining to employees of the Bureau of
6 Legislative Research;

7 (2)(A) Actions concerning the hiring or termination of
8 staff, staff promotions, and proposed salary changes;

9 (B) Nothing in this section shall be construed to
10 create an employment contract, any salary obligation, other obligation, or
11 change in employment status of staff of the Bureau of Legislative Research
12 from an at-will employment relationship.

13 (3) Establishing new, repealing, or changing any other
14 policies or procedures of the Bureau of Legislative Research relating to the
15 delivery of services and other matters pertaining to the operation of the
16 Bureau of Legislative Research, including the biennial budget request of the
17 Bureau of Legislative Research.
