29 SECTION 9. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 30 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. CARRY 31 FORWARD. Any unexpended balance of appropriation approved for the purchase 32 of computer software and hardware by Item (07) in Section 3 of this Act, 33 which remains at the close of the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004 2006, 34 shall be carried forward and made available for the same purpose for the 35 fiscal year ending June 30, 2005 2007 after having received prior approval by 36 the Arkansas Legislative Council or Joint Budget Committee.

1 Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of 2 appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year 3 is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by 4 delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and 5 the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by 6 amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. 1 of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any 2 proposed expenditures would cause the Workers' Compensation Fund to decline 3 below four million twenty five thousand five hundred ninety one dollars 4 (\$4,025,591) three million four hundred forty four thousand two hundred 5 dollars (\$3,440,200), the Death and Permanent Total Disability Trust Fund to 6 decline below sixty eight million, six thousand five hundred fifty one 7 dollars (\$68,006,551) sixty nine million, nine hundred forty nine thousand 8 seven hundred forty dollars (\$69,949,740)or the Second Injury Trust Fund to 9 decline below five million four hundred nine thousand six hundred six dollars (\$5,409,606) three million two hundred twenty nine thousand eight hundred 10 11 forty one dollars (\$3,229,841), the disbursing officer shall immediately 12 notify the executive head of the agency. Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the agency head shall file written documentation 13 14 with the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State requesting approval of the 15 expenditures. Such documentation shall provide sufficient financial data to 16 justify the expenditures and shall include the following: 17 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such expenditures on the fund balance. 18 19 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance. 20 21 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs 22 or one-time purchase of capitalized items. 23 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not 24 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent 25 depletion of the fund balance. 26 (B) The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and 27 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought 28 prior review by the Legislative Council. 29 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 30 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007. 31 SECTION 12. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. 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6 SECTION 13. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 7 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 8 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 9 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 10 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 11 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 12 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 13 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

15 SECTION 14. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 16 17 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of 18 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 19 20 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the 21 22 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 23 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 24 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 25 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005. 26 27 /s/ Joint Budget Committee 28 29 30 31
