SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 10 11 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 12 TRANSFER. (a) Regular Salary and Personal Services Matching for one (1) Attorney Specialist, Grade 25 position as authorized in Section 1 herein, to 13 be used for Drug Law Enforcement, shall be funded only from funds transferred 14 15 from the Special State Asset Forfeiture Fund to the State Central 16 Services Fund as direct revenues to the Office of Prosecutor Coordinator. 17 (b) On July 1, 2003 2005, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and State 18 Treasurer shall transfer the sum of fifty three thousand nine hundred thirty 19 three dollars (\$53,933) fifty five thousand five hundred fifty dollars (\$55,550), from the Special State Asset Forfeiture Fund to the State Central 20 21 Services Fund there to be used for such purposes as stated in (a) herein. 22 (c) On July 1, 2004 2006, the Chief Fiscal Officer of the State and State 23 Treasurer shall transfer the sum of fifty five thousand three hundred eighty 24 nine dollars (\$55,389) fifty seven thousand fifty one dollars (\$57,051), from 25 the Special State Asset Forfeiture Fund to the State Central Services Fund 26 there to be used for such purposes as stated in (a) herein. 27 (d) The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 28 2005 through June 30, 2005 2007.

30 SECTION 5. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 31 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 32 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 33 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 34 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 35 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 36 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by

SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 4 5 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 6 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 7 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 8 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 9 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral 10 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 11 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption. 12

13 SECTION 7. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 14 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 15 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the 16 effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of 17 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 18 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the 19 20 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 21 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 22 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 23 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005. 24 25 */s/ Joint Budget Committee* 26 27
