SECTION 2. EXTRA HELP - OPERATIONS. - 35 the following new sections:

     AUTHORITY. The Director of the Department of Education - Division of Public
17
     School Academic Facilities and Transportation, with the approval of the Chief
18
     Fiscal Officer of the State and after approval by the Arkansas Legislative
19
     Council or Joint Budget Committee, is hereby authorized to request necessary
20
     appropriation transfers and any other budget related adjustments necessary
     for the appropriations authorized herein. Furthermore, it is the intent of
21

     the General Assembly that the Department of Education - Division of Public

     School Academic Facilities and Transportation be able to make use of

     additional contractual services as necessary and that transfers between line
25
     items and among appropriations are anticipated to accomplish those purposes.

        Determining the maximum number of employees and the maximum amount of
27
     appropriation and general revenue funding for a state agency each fiscal year
28
     is the prerogative of the General Assembly. This is usually accomplished by
29
     delineating such maximums in the appropriation act(s) for a state agency and
30
     the general revenue allocations authorized for each fund and fund account by
     amendment to the Revenue Stabilization law. Further, the General Assembly

     has determined that the Department of Education - Division of Public School

     Academic Facilities and Transportation may operate more efficiently if some

     flexibility is provided to the Director of the Department of Education -

     Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation authorizing

     broad powers under the Transfer Authority provision herein. Therefore, it is

- 1 both necessary and appropriate that the General Assembly maintain oversight

- SECTION 10. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized 11
- 12 by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds
- 13 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the
- restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 14
- 15 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary
- 16 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal
- 17 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by
- the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be 18
- 19 strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds.

- 21 SECTION 11. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly
- 22 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained
- 2.3 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act
- 24 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations
- 25 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by
- 26 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral
- 27 testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or
- 28 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

- 30 SECTION 12. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General
- 31 Assembly, that funds provided by the General Assembly for the operations of
- the Department of Education Division of Public School Academic Facilities 32
- 33 and Transportation are, due to unforeseen circumstances, insufficient for the
- Department of Education Division of Public School Academic Facilities and 34
- 35 Transportation to continue to provide essential governmental services; that

the provisions of this act will provide the necessary monies for the 36

Department of Education - Division of Public School Academic Facilities and Transportation to continue such services; and that a delay in the effective date of this Act could work irreparable harm upon the proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety shall be in full force and effect from and after the date of its passage and approval. If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor, it shall become effective on the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the bill. If the bill is vetoed by the Governor and the veto is overridden, it shall become effective on the date the last house overrides the veto.
