1 2 SECTION 4. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. FUND 3 4 BALANCES - DEPARTMENT OF AERONAUTICS FUND. (A) For all appropriations as 5 provided in this Act, the agency disbursing officer shall monitor the level 6 of fund balances in relation to expenditures on a monthly basis. If any 7 proposed expenditures would cause the Department of Aeronautics Fund to 8 decline below four million two hundred ten thousand one hundred and six 9 dollars (\$4,210,106) two million one hundred thousand dollars (\$2,100,000), the disbursing officer shall immediately notify the executive head of the 10 11 agency. Prior to any obligations being made under these circumstances, the 12 agency head shall file written documentation with the Chief Fiscal Officer of 13 the State requesting approval of the expenditures. Such documentation shall 14 provide sufficient financial data to justify the expenditures and shall 15 include the following: 16 1) a plan that clearly indicates the specific fiscal impact of such 17 expenditures on the fund balance. 2) information clearly indicating and explaining what programs would be cut 18 19 or any other measures to be taken by the agency to restore the fund balance. 20 3) the extent to which any of the planned expenditures are for one-time costs 21 or one-time purchase of capitalized items. 22 4) a statement certifying that the expenditure of fund balances will not 23 jeopardize the financial health of the agency, nor result in a permanent 24 depletion of the fund balance. 25 The Chief Fiscal Officer of the State shall review the request and (B) 26 approve or disapprove all or any part of the request, after having sought 27 prior review by the Legislative Council. 28 The provisions of this section shall be in effect only from July 1, 2003 29 2005 through June 30, <del>2005</del> 2007. 30 31 SECTION 5. SPECIAL LANGUAGE. NOT TO BE INCORPORATED INTO THE ARKANSAS 32 CODE NOR PUBLISHED SEPARATELY AS SPECIAL, LOCAL AND TEMPORARY LAW. 33 DISTRIBUTIONS AND TRANSFERS. For any duplicate distributions or transfers erroneously made to the Arkansas Department of Aeronautics Fund established 34 35 by Arkansas Code 19-6-402 during the fiscal years 1999 through 2004, shall remain in the fund there to be used for the purposes as provided by law. 36

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2 SECTION 6. COMPLIANCE WITH OTHER LAWS. Disbursement of funds authorized by this act shall be limited to the appropriation for such agency and funds 3 4 made available by law for the support of such appropriations; and the 5 restrictions of the State Procurement Law, the General Accounting and 6 Budgetary Procedures Law, the Revenue Stabilization Law, the Regular Salary 7 Procedures and Restrictions Act, or their successors, and other fiscal 8 control laws of this State, where applicable, and regulations promulgated by 9 the Department of Finance and Administration, as authorized by law, shall be strictly complied with in disbursement of said funds. 10

12 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the General Assembly 13 that any funds disbursed under the authority of the appropriations contained 14 in this act shall be in compliance with the stated reasons for which this act 15 was adopted, as evidenced by the Agency Requests, Executive Recommendations 16 and Legislative Recommendations contained in the budget manuals prepared by 17 the Department of Finance and Administration, letters, or summarized oral testimony in the official minutes of the Arkansas Legislative Council or 18 19 Joint Budget Committee which relate to its passage and adoption.

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21 SECTION 8. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. It is found and determined by the General 22 Assembly, that the Constitution of the State of Arkansas prohibits the 23 appropriation of funds for more than a two (2) year period; that the effectiveness of this Act on July 1, 2005 is essential to the operation of 24 25 the agency for which the appropriations in this Act are provided, and that in 26 the event of an extension of the Regular Session, the delay in the effective 27 date of this Act beyond July 1, 2005 could work irreparable harm upon the 28 proper administration and provision of essential governmental programs. 29 Therefore, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this Act being 30 necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and 31 safety shall be in full force and effect from and after July 1, 2005. 32 33 /s/ Joint Budget Committee 34

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
