35 (a) There is created the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission,

36 hereinafter referred to as the commission, to be composed of nine (9) members

1 to be appointed by the Covernor for terms of seven (7) years, subject to 2 confirmation by the Senate. 3 (b)(1) One (1) commissioner shall be appointed from each of the four 4 (4) congressional districts of the state as constituted July 1, 1975, and 5 five (5) members of the commission, including the consumer representative and 6 the representative of the elderly, shall be appointed from the state at 7 large. 8 (2)(A) Four (4) members of the commission shall be licensees or 9 shall be qualified as licensees under the provisions of this chapter at the 10 time of their appointment. 11 (B) Five (5) members of the commission shall be appointed 12 from the public at large, including the consumer representative and the 13 representative of the elderly. 14 (C) No more than four (4) members of the commission shall 15 at any time be licensees under this chapter or have any financial interest 16 in, or be an officer or an employee of, a licensee of this chapter, and at 17 least one (1) of them shall be licensed as a dealer of franchise motorcycles. 18 (3) The consumer representative and the representative of the 19 elderly shall not be actively engaged in or retired from the businesses 20 regulated by this chapter. The two (2) positions may not be held by the same 21 person. Both shall be full voting members. The representative of the elderly 22 shall be sixty (60) years of age or older. 23 (4) Each of the members appointed shall be a citizen of the 24 United States, a resident of the State of Arkansas, and a qualified elector 25 of the jurisdiction from which appointed, and each shall be of good moral 26 character. 27 (c) In the event a vacancy on the commission occurs due to death, 28 resignation, or other reason, the vacancy shall be filled for the unexpired 29 portion of the term by appointment of the Governor, subject to confirmation 30 by the Senate, of a person meeting the same qualifications required for the 31 initial appointment. 32 (d) Each commission member shall serve until his or her successor is 33 appointed and qualified. 34 (c) The commission shall select by majority vote of its members one 35 (1) of its members as a chair, one (1) as a vice chair, and one (1) as a
