14	suspended or revoked driver's license should be collected for each offense or		
15	for each reinstatement; that due to the confusion, state agencies have not		
16	been allowed to collect the revenue that they anticipated for reinstatement		
17	fees which is causing a negative fiscal impact; and that this act is		
18	immediately necessary to clarify the law to prevent the impairment of agency		
19	operations due to a loss of anticipated revenue. Therefore, an emergency is		
20	declared to exist and this act being immediately necessary for the		
21	preservation of the public peace, health, and safety shall become effective		
22	on:		
23	(1) The date of its approval by the Governor;		
24	(2) If the bill is neither approved nor vetoed by the Governor,		
25	the expiration of the period of time during which the Governor may veto the
