13	Management's Discussion and Analysis — for State and Local Governments",		
14	places an undue burden on the prosecuting attorneys within the State of		
15	Arkansas; that prosecuting attorneys in the State of Arkansas already face		
16	many pressures and requirements and do not have adequate personnel to prepare		
17	financial statements as required by Statement No. 34, and another basis of		
18	financial statement presentation will meet the needs of the General Assembly,		
19	the Department of Education, the school districts, and the people of the		
20	State of Arkansas; and that this act is immediately necessary to assist		
21	prosecuting attorneys. Therefore, an emergency is declared to exist and this
